

1	Seat cover, rider	1
2	Seat cover, passenger	1

1 Remove the bolt (1) from the front of the grab rail, and repeat on the other side of the vehicle. Retain the bolts for reuse.



6mm hexagonal bit and socket wrench




2 Lift the front of the passenger seat and unhook it from the frame. Remove the top hat inserts (2) from both sides, retaining them for reuse.




3 Remove the two bolts (3) and sleeves (4) securing the rider seat to the chassis. Retain the bolts and sleeves for reuse. Lift the rider's seat from the rear and pull rearwards to remove it.




10mm bi-hexagonal socket and wrench




4 Fit the passenger seat cover over the seat, ensuring it is aligned correctly. Ensure the mount points of the seat pass through the holes in the cover (5). Pull the strings (6) tight and secure with a knot. Tuck the knot under the cover (7) and tie the elastic cords (8) tightly as shown.






5 For the rider's seat, position the cover over the seat, ensuring the mount points pass through the holes in the cover (9). Pull the strings (10) tight and secure with a knot. Tuck the knot under the cover and tie the elastic cords tightly as shown (11).



6 Locate the front of the rider's seat onto the tab behind the fuel tank and align the rear mounting points with their corresponding holes on the frame. Reinsert the two sleeves (4) and two bolts (3) and tighten to 12Nm.



10mm bi-hexagonal socket and torque wrench




7 Hook the passenger seat into the frame at the rear and align the front mounting holes. Ensure that all cords are tucked away under the seat and reinsert the bolt (1) through the grabrail boss and into the frame. Repeat for the other side of the vehicle. Tighten the bolts to **25Nm**.
